

Pathways to Permits Traditional Rafting (B1 waters)

A progression pathway that will enable adults to obtain a <u>permit to lead Traditional</u> (<u>Improvised</u>) rafting on B1 waters. The maximum number of rafts on an unrestricted leadership permit for rafting on B1 waters is three rafts. The scope of the permit will be determined during the permit assessment and restrictions to one or two rafts may be applied in the short term until more experience has been gained.

It is recommended that those wishing to lead rafting on **Class C** waters also complete the day-long training course to support them with the safe operation of the activity.

Class C - safe inland waters which are less than 100m wide where flow causes little effect (including swimming pools);

Class B1 - sheltered inland waters and other sheltered water where currents and tides create no real danger;

Logbook of leadership experience:

Before being assessed for a permit, the assessor will expect to see a log of your leadership experience, either in the role of assisting an existing permit holder lead a session or in the role of a session leader operating under the permit of an existing permit holder.
