


Pathways to Permits

Bell Boating (B1 waters)

A progression pathway that will enable adults to obtain a <u>permit to lead Bell Boating</u> on B1 waters. A leadership permit allows the holder to lead one bell boat. A supervisory permit allows the holder to supervise three bell boats providing they remain in communication with each boat leader and have ready access to a rescue craft. The scope of the permit will be determined during the permit assessment and restrictions may be applied in terms of the waters on which the bell boats can be used.

B1 waters - sheltered inland waters and other sheltered water where currents and tides create no real danger.

No previous paddlesport experience is needed to train for a permit to lead a Bell Boat. They are an ideal first step into paddlesport, especially suitable for Beavers and Cubs.
